creates a surprisingly significant improvement in patient experience. *“There are so many nuances to what I do,”* says Dr. Rizk. *“The surgical glue is just the icing on the cake.”* The result? Patients are often back at their desks and fully camera-ready within two weeks. A timeline that’s virtually unheard of in facelift surgery.

With over 3,000 facelifts and 6,000 rhinoplasties performed, Dr. Rizk is as prolific as he is precise. What’s more telling is that a quarter of his patients travel from outside New York, and around 20% come from abroad. The demographic is changing, too. Increasingly, his facelift patients are in their early 40s. A cohort that includes executives, founders, financiers, and creatives who view aesthetics not as vanity, but as an asset. I worked mostly with clay, stone, and alabaster, and drew inspiration from the classics—Lysippus, Michelangelo, and Donatello. But my father was a doctor, and I found myself drawn to that world too. It wasn’t until I got to medical school and became interested in facial anatomy that I realized I could combine my two interests and make a career out of sculpting faces.”

It’s this fusion of form and function that defines his work today: each procedure is guided

not just by anatomy, but by aesthetics honed over decades of visual study and sculptural discipline.
